THIS PRIVACY STATEMENT FORMS PART OF THE SAFETY STREET (PTY) LTD WEBSITE TERMS AND CONDITIONS. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH ANY TERM OF THIS PRIVACY STATEMENT, YOU MUST CEASE YOUR ACCESS OF THIS WEBSITE IMMEDIATELY.

1. Definitions and Interpretation

1.1. "SAFETY STREET (PTY) LTD" means BUCKSTOP.

1.2. "Personal Information" means information relating to an identifiable, living, natural person and where it is applicable, identifiable, existing juristic person, including all information as defined in the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013.

1.3. "Processing" means the creation, generation, communication, storage, destruction of personal information as more fully defined in the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013.

1.4. "You" or the "user" means any person who accesses and browses this website for any purpose.

1.5. "Website" means the website of BUCKSTOP at URL www.buckstop.co.za or such other URL as BUCKSTOP may choose from time to time.

2. Status and Amendments

2.1. BUCKSTOP respects your privacy. This privacy policy statement sets out BUCKSTOP information gathering and dissemination practices in respect of the Website.

2.2. This Privacy Policy governs the processing of personal information provided to BUCKSTOP through your use of the Website.

2.3. Please note that, due to legal and other developments, BUCKSTOP may amend these terms and conditions from time to time. The version of the terms and conditions effective for this Privacy Policy are indicated by the effective date incorporated in the title of this Privacy Policy. It is your duty to remain apprised of the current version of this Privacy Policy. The date indicated in the heading of this Privacy Policy is the effective date that governs the browsing and use of this Privacy Policy from that date until the next revision of this Privacy Policy becomes effective.

2.4. By continuing to browse or use this Privacy Statement after a revised Privacy Policy becomes effective constitutes your agreement to observe this Privacy Policy as may be revised.

3. Processing of Personal Information

3.1. BUCKSTOP may collect your personal information on the website using various means:

- 3.1.1. Subscribing to our newsletter.
- 3.1.2. Registering on our blog or forum.
- 3.1.3. Submitting your details via a contact form.
- 3.1.4. Through the personalisation of a website by a user.
- 3.1.5. The use of cookies.
- 3.1.6. Monitoring user access and habits.
- 3.1.7. Sending or receiving emails.
- 3.1.8. SMS's or other similar communication messaging.

3.2. By providing your personal information to BUCKSTOP you acknowledge that it has been collected directly from you and consent to its processing by BUCKSTOP.

3.3. Where you submit Personal Information (such as name, address, telephone number and email address) via the website (e.g. through completing any online form) the following principles are observed in the processing of that information:

3.3.1. BUCKSTOP will only collect personal information for a purpose consistent with the purpose for which it is required. The specific purpose for which information is collected will be apparent from the context in which it is requested.

3.3.2. To send you a quote or invoice you, we might collect your publicly available personal information from the Internet. For example, your address or VAT registration number.

3.3.3. We are required by law to verify the identity of our clients. As such we may ask you to provide us with various personal information.

3.3.4. BUCKSTOP will only process personal information in a manner that is adequate, relevant and not excessive in the context of the purpose for which it is processed.

3.3.5. Personal information will only be processed for a purpose compatible with that for which it was collected, unless you have agreed to an alternative purpose in writing or BUCKSTOP is permitted in terms of national legislation of general application dealing primarily with the protection of personal information.

3.3.6. BUCKSTOP will keep records of all personal Information collected and the specific purpose for which it was collected for a period of 5 (five) years from the date on which it was last used.

3.3.7. BUCKSTOP will not disclose any personal information relating to you to any third party unless your prior written agreement is obtained or BUCKSTOP is required to do so by law.

3.3.8. If personal information is released with your consent BUCKSTOP will retain a record of the information released, the third party to which it was released, the reason for the release and the date of release, for a period of 5 (five) years from the date on which it was last used.

3.3.9. BUCKSTOP will destroy or delete any personal information that is no longer needed by BUCKSTOP for the purpose it was initially collected, or subsequently processed.

3.4. Note that, as permitted by the Electronic Communications and Transactions Act 25 of 2002, BUCKSTOP may use personal information collected to compile profiles for statistical purposes. No information contained in the profiles or statistics will be able to be linked to any specific user.

3.5. BUCKSTOP may use your personal information to:

3.5.1. Respond to your enquiries.

3.5.2. Provide you more information about our services.

3.5.3. Improve our service to you by analysing it for trends.

3.5.4. Invite you to attend events we hold.

3.5.5. Send you updates on the latest trends and new products we have in stock.

3.5.6. Send you marketing material (including electronic communications) relating to other industry information you might be interested in. You can unsubscribe at any time by clicking on the link in the communication we would have sent you, and thereafter we will not market to you.

3.6. Access to and Correction of Personal Information

3.6.1. You may access and correct, if necessary, your personal information that we hold by emailing us at admin@buckstop.co.za.

4. Collection of anonymous data

4.1. BUCKSTOP may use standard technology to collect information about the use of this website. This technology is not able to identify individual users but simply allows BUCKSTOP to collect statistics.

4.2. BUCKSTOP may utilise temporary or session cookies to keep track of users' browsing habits. A cookie is a small file that is placed on your hard drive, in order to keep a record of your interaction with this website and facilitate user convenience.

4.2.1. Cookies by themselves will not be used to identify users personally but may be used to compile details of identified statistics relating to use of services offered or to provide BUCKSTOP with feedback on the performance of this website.

4.2.2. The following classes of information may be collected in respect of users who have enabled cookies:

4.2.2.1. The browser software used;

4.2.2.2. IP address;

4.2.2.3. Date and time of activities while visiting the website;

4.2.2.4. URLs of internal pages visited; and

4.2.2.5. referrers.

4.3. If you do not wish cookies to be employed to customize your interaction with this website, it is possible to alter the manner in which your browser handles cookies.
